Sweden's favourite female detective returns to solve more high profile murder cases on the beautiful island of Gotland.

Following her husband's tragic death, Detective Maria Wern moved her young family to Gotland. Known as an idyllic holiday island favoured by Swedish tourists during the summer months, the police on Gotland are used to dealing with petty crime and speeding tickets. However big city cases seem to follow Maria from Stockholm, and a series of high profile murders make it difficult for her to change her pace of life. As well as her police work, Maria must battle with the various stresses of her personal life; raising a family alone, grieving for her lost husband, and dealing with the advances, both welcome and otherwise, of new love interests.
